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THIS MATTER came before the Garden City, Planning and Zoning Commission for consideration on July 17, 2024. The Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed the application and materials submitted. Based on the evidence presented, pursuant to Garden City Code Table 8-6A-1, the Planning and Zoning Commission makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The applicant is Garden City.
- 2. The application is to amend permit extensions by providing uniform and reasonable time periods for extensions on permits governed by the development code.
- 3. The following section of the Garden City Development Code are amended by this proposal:
