TOWN OF JEFFERSON ORDINANCE 2-11 TO CREATE EXTRATERRITORIAL ZONING COMMITTEE

The Town Board of the Town of Jefferson does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Jefferson and the City of Fort Atkinson each have created a City Planning Commission and have adopted a zoning ordinance and may exercise extraterritorial zoning power as set forth in Section 62.23(7a); and

WHEREAS, the City of Jefferson and the City of Fort Atkinson each have adopted a resolution under Section 62.23(7a), and directed its Planning Commission to formulate recommendations for the District Plan and regulations within all or a part of the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction as described in its resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Jefferson does hereby create an Extraterritorial Zoning Committee pursuant to Section 62.23(7a)(c). Said Extraterritorial Zoning Committee shall consist of three (3) town members appointed by the Town Board for three (3) year terms and shall be residents of the Town and persons of recognized experience and qualifications. Town Board members are eligible to serve. These three (3) appointed town members shall work together with City representatives on the Extraterritorial Zoning Committee.

EFFECTIVE DATE, This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted at a meeting of the Town Board of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, on the 7th day of February, 2011.
