The Village of Star Prairie will hold a Public Hearing on the proposed Comprehensive Plan at the Star Prairie Community Center, 207 Bridge Avenue, Star Prairie, Wisconsin, at 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 14, 2026.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to hear comments and recommendations on the comprehensive plan for citizens of Star Prairie and other interested parties.

The comprehensive plan includes all nine elements required by Wisconsin Statutes 66.1001 (2) including Issues and Opportunities, Housing, Transportation, Utilities and Community Facilities, Agricultural, Natural and Cultural Resources, Economic Development, Intergovernmental Cooperation, Land Use and Implementation. This comprehensive plan will guide the growth and development of the Village over the next twenty years. The comprehensive plan will be the basis for future land use decisions affecting subdivisions, zoning, and public investment in infrastructure.
