
Broadcast of Meetings and Events on Channel 300 and YouTube

510.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The Town of Rome Channel 300, and YouTube channel(s) exists for the live broad cast and rebroadcast of official town meetings including subcommittees, boards, commissions and other Town government related information.

510.2 POLICY

Channel 300 and Town of Rome YouTube Channel(s) are not a community television channels open to individuals and groups outside of the responsibility of the Town government. The channel's purpose is to more broadly involve citizens in Town issues and workings effecting town residents.

To promote this goal, the following meeting broadcasts are provided by the town:

- (a) Regular and Special Town Board
- (b) Plan Commission
- (c) Zoning Board of Appeals
- (d) Police and Fire Commission
- (e) Community Development Authority
- (f) Board of Review
- (g) Parks and Recreation Committee
- (h) Alcohol Beverage License Review Committee
- (i) Utilities Committee
- (j) Any other town governmental committee, sub-committee, task force, etc. that holds meetings in the Town Board or Community Room

The Town will also air the following events:

- (a) Town of Rome Candidate forums
- (b) Tri-Lakes Management meetings

To be broadcast live, the meetings must be held in the Town Hall. To have a prerecorded meeting be broadcast later, the board or commission must submit a copy of the meeting in the format the town uses and of a quality suitable for broadcast.

Other use of this channel and equipment requires approval of the Town Board.
