



**Resolution to Accept SLFRF funds
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-1**

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)

WHEREAS, since the first case of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) was discovered in the United States in January 2020, the disease has infected over 80 million and killed over 885,000 Americans ("Pandemic"). The disease has impacted every part of life: as social distancing became a necessity, businesses closed, schools transitioned to remote education, travel was sharply reduced, and millions of Americans lost their jobs.

AND, WHEREAS Congress adopted the American Rescue Plan Act in March 2021 ("ARPA") which included \$19.53 billion in recovery funds for non-entitlement units of government (local governments with under 50,000 population) across the country.

AND, WHEREAS ARPA funds are intended to provide support to state, local, and tribal governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 in their communities, residents, and businesses.

AND, WHEREAS, \$336,195.40 has been allocated to the Town of Oakland ("Town") pursuant to the ARPA ("Allocation").

AND, WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury has adopted guidance regarding the use of ARPA funds.

AND, WHEREAS, the Town, in response to the Pandemic, has plans for future expenditures consistent with the Department of Treasury's ARPA guidance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF OAKLAND BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town intends to collect its share of ARPA funds from the State of Wisconsin to use in a manner consistent with the Department of Treasury's guidance.
2. Town staff, together with the Town of Oakland Board of Supervisors are hereby authorized to take any actions necessary to receive the Town's share of ARPA funds from the State of Wisconsin for Pandemic related expenses.
3. The Town of Oakland has elected to use the standard allowance of up to \$10 million, not to exceed our total award allocation, for identifying revenue loss.
