The following resolution was passed at the Annual Town Meeting - Oakland Township, Jefferson County, Wisc., April 4, 1972.  
Directed to the attention of Cambridge Community School Board and Administrator.  
That a student, teacher ratio be set at no less than (25) twenty-five students to (1) one teacher.  
This action would eliminate roughly 15 teachers and a saving to the taxpayers about \$150,000.00 per year.  
It is also felt that a tight austerity program be used in other areas of the school operation effecting further tax dollar savings.

Further, that all administrative, principals, teachers, custodial and any other salaries of the school employment be frozen or reduced and to eliminate all teaching assistants.

That any and all item in the budget may only be used for its stipulated use and no diversion of said funds to other use.

That the Administrator be directed to mail a detailed copy of any future budget to all property owners of the Cambridge Community School, ten (10) days prior to the yearly school budget meeting.

Your earnest and dedicated attention to the above resolution is expected.
