

RESOLUTION NO. 1003

TOWN OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2001, the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors adopted a Tentative Supervisory District Plan in accordance with State Statute 59.03; and

WHEREAS, each local unit of government in Jefferson County is required to establish wards within 60 days of the county adoption of the plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin that the following ward boundaries, encompassing the total population for the municipality of 3,135, are established as of this date, June 26, 2001:

Ward Number 1 -- Population	652
Ward Number 2 -- Population	911
Ward Number 3 -- Population	896
Ward Number 4 -- Population	<u>676</u>
Total Population	3,135

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the geographical boundaries which make up each ward are described as follows, with the point of beginning in the northwest corner of each ward:

Ward Number 1

Northwest corner of town line east to Hope Lake Road and CTH A intersection, south to USH 18, west on USH 18 to Park Road, southwest on Park Road to USH 12, southeast on USH 12 to CTH A, south on CTH A to CTH C, west on CTH C to the town line, north on town line to Village of Cambridge boundaries, then east and north around the Village of Cambridge annexed area to USH 18, west to the Koshkonong Creek town line, north to the Village of Cambridge annexed area, east to the Koshkonong Creek, north along Koshkonong Creek to the end of the Cambridge annexed area, west to the Christiana/Oakland town line, north to the point of beginning.

Ward Number 2

Intersection of Park Road and USH 18, east to Wolff Road, south to Beach Drive, south to a point on the lake shore directly south of Beach Drive, south following the lake shore to Island Lane, south to USH 12, northwest to Park Road, northeast to the point of beginning.

Ward Number 3

Intersection of Hope Lake Road and CTH A, east on the town line to the northeast corner of town line, south on CTH G town line to CTH J and CTH G intersection, west and south on CTH J to USH 12, northwest to Island Lane, north to lake shore and follow lake shore to point on the lake shore directly south of Beach Drive, north on Beach Drive to Wolff Road, north to USH 18, east to CTH A, north to the point of beginning.

Ward Number 4

Intersection of CTH A and USH 12 and Langhoff Lane, east on USH 12 to town line, south on town line to the southeast corner of town line, west on town line to southwest corner of town line, north on town line to Hoopen Road, east to CTH C, east to CTH A, north to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wards 1, 2, 3 and 4 created above are hereby combined for voting purposes, so as to share the common polling place, the Oakland Town Hall, W8536 USH 12, Fort Atkinson, Wisconsin. Such combined wards shall use common ballot boxes and ballots and separate returns shall not be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required under Section 5.58 to 5.64 of the Statutes, and separate ballots shall be maintained for any electors of one or more of the combined wards who are ineligible to vote for any office or referendum for which other electors on the combined wards may vote.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Town Clerk, who shall transmit a copy of the ward plan and this resolution to the County Clerk within five days of its adoption and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Statute, or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.


