

RESOLUTION NO. 1006

RESOLUTION
PROVIDING FOR
ADVISORY REFERENDUM QUESTION
ON NEW BUILDING COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, desires to obtain input from the Town's electors regarding the construction of a new building complex, and

WHEREAS, the question is to be presented to the electors of the Town of Oakland at a referendum to be held on November 5, 2002.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, that this is an advisory question only, intended to determine the consensus of the constituents on the issue of constructing a new building complex. The results of the referendum will be used to assist the Town Board in determining whether or not to proceed with any such construction.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:
