An Ordinance to regulate traffic upon the streets, alleys and highways of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County and State of Wisconsin.

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County and State of Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. TRAFFIC REGULATIONS. The following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes, Laws of 1947, are hereby adopted and made a part and portion of this ordinand for the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin:

Sections 85.06; 85.10; 85.12; 85.13; 85.14; 85.15; 85.16; 85.17; 85.18; 85.19; 85.20; 85.21; 85.22; 85.23; 85.24; 85.25; 85.26; 85.27; 85.29; 85.30; 85.31; 85.32; 85.33; 85.34; 85.35; 85.36; 85.37; 85.38; 85.39; 85.44; 85.56; 85.57; 85.58; 85.59; 85.61; 85.62; 85.63; 85.64; 85.65; 85.66; 85.67; 85.69; 85.75 and 85.81.

Section 2. (a) The provisions of sections 85.40 and 85.41 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1947 are adopted as part of this ordinand, except as hereinafter provided pursuant to section 85.40 (3) of said statutes.

(b) The maximum permissible speed shall be ~~forty~~ (20) miles per hour on the following defined highways within the areas designated:

1. On the town highway extending East and Northeasterly along the North side of Lake Ripley, from the Cambridge-Lake Mills highway, Easterly to the first North-South highway lying Northeast of said Lake.

(c) The Town Constable shall provide, place and maintain standard signs giving notice of the decrease in speed herein provided.

(d) The statutory speed limits or the decreased limits provided in section 2(b) of this ordinand shall not apply to authorized emergency vehicles while operating in emergencies.

(e) The maximum permissible speed shall be thirty (30) miles per hour on the Cambridge-Lake Mills highway extending Northerly from U.S. Highway #12 to U.S. Highway #18; also, the town highway extending Northerly from U.S. Highway #12, lying East of Lake Ripley and continuing Northerly to a point where the same turns Westerly on the North side of Lake Ripley.

Section 3. ADVERTISING. No person shall operate or park on any town highway, any vehicle for the primary purpose of advertising.

Section 4. PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished as follows:

(a) If for a violation of any provisions of this ordinance enacted by reference to any section of the Wisconsin Statutes, by forfeiting to the Town of Oakland a like amount of money provided as and for a fine in section 85.91 of the 1947 Wisconsin Statutes, to which extent said portion of said section 85.91 is hereby adopted by reference, and the costs of prosecution; and in default of payment of the forfeiture and cost of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the Jefferson County Jail, until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not to exceed sixty (60) days.

(b) If for a violation of any other provision of this ordinance, by forfeiting to the Town of Oakland of not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$10.00 for the first offense, and for the second or each subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, by forfeiting to the Town of Oakland not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$25.00 and in default of payment of such forfeiture and the cost of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the Jefferson County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Oakland presently in force which are in conflict with

the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
