

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF OAKLAND IN JEFFERSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
relating to the regulation of traffic upon the streets, alleys and
highways in said Town.

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland do ordain as follows:

Section 1

The existing Ordinance Number 2 of the Town of Oakland dated
the 26th day of May, 1956, creating an ordinance regulating traffic
upon the streets, alleys and highways of said Town is hereby repealed
and this ordinance adopted to take its place.

Section 2 - Traffic Regulations

The following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes,
Laws of 1961, are hereby incorporated by reference into this ordinance
and adopted as a part of this ordinance with the same effect as if
set forth in full. However, any provisions contained in said Statutes
pertaining to fines or penalties are specifically excluded from this
ordinance.

Section 3

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance may be punished by forfeiting to the Town of Oakland not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00 for the first offense, and for the second or each subsequent conviction within one year thereafter by forfeiting to the Town of Oakland not less than \$3.00 nor more than \$150.00 together with costs of prosecution in each instance and in default of payment of such forfeiture and the costs of prosecution, the convicted party shall be imprisoned in the Jefferson County Jail for not to exceed sixty (60) days or until said forfeiture has been paid.

Section 4

Pursuant to Section 345.14, Wisconsin Statutes, the following form is adopted and may be used as a Stipulation:

, the undersigned, declares under penalties of perjury that he has been charged with violating Ordinance No. 2 of the Town of Oakland, the specific violation being as follows:

That said violation occurred on the _____ day of _____, 19_____. That the undersigned hereby (stipulates and admits that he is guilty as charged) or (pleads nolo contendere to said charge) and further consents that he forfeits as a penalty for said offense, without a Court Order or hearing, the sum of \$_____ to the Town of Oakland under the condition that no other court costs or fee will be charged because of this violation.

The undersigned further states that he has been informed, as provided in Section 343.27, Wisconsin Statutes, that this

violation will be reported to the Motor Vehicle Department and that he will lose points and/or his driver's license because of said violation.

In presence of:

The Town Constable and/or the officer employed by the Town of Oakland may use the above form and accept the forfeiture. Said forfeiture not to be in excess of the forfeitures set up in Section 3 of this ordinance for the same violation. The officer receiving said forfeiture shall deposit the same with the Town Treasurer within twenty (20) days of its receipt. The use of this Stipulation, however, is limited to the first offense the individual is charged with in this Town. The officer receiving said Stipulation shall comply with Section 343.27 and 343.29, Wisconsin Statutes of 1961.

Section 5

The Town Constable and/or the officer employed by the Town of Oakland is authorized to place and maintain standard signs supplied by the Town giving notice of speed limitations and other regulations enacted by this ordinance.

Section 6

Any portions of any other existing ordinance of the Town of Oakland which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7

In the event any portion of this ordinance is in conflict with any provisions of Chapter 340 through 349 of the Statutes of the State of Wisconsin and this Town Board is not granted the authority to change the provisions as set forth in this ordinance, then the portion of the ordinance being in conflict shall be amended so as to conform with such Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

Section 8

It is the intention of this Town Board to adopt this ordinance pursuant to the authority granted by Section 349.06, Wisconsin Statutes of 1961.

Section 9

In the event any portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid by Judgment or Court Order, it is the intention of this Board to have the other provisions remain in full force and effect. The invalidation of one portion of this ordinance shall, therefore, not affect the validity of the entire ordinance.

Section 10

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.
