



ORDINANCE NO. 64

An Ordinance repealing and recreating Ordinance No. 4 regulating the use of Rifles in the Town of Oakland during all Deer Hunting Firearm seasons approved by the Wisconsin DNR

THIS ORDINANCE, NO. 64, RECREATES ORDINANCE NO. 4:
REGULATING THE USE OF RIFLES IN THE TOWN OF OAKLAND
DURING ALL DEER HUNTING FIREARM SEASONS APPROVED BY
THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN that Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4 of the Town of Oakland is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

A. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 29, WIS. STATS.

The provisions of Chapter 29 of the Wisconsin Statutes, relating to fish and game, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference so far as applicable and exclusive of penalty except as otherwise lawfully provided by Town Ordinance.

B. USE OF RIFLES


The use of rifles shall be allowed for the use of deer hunting in the Town of Oakland during all deer hunting firearm seasons approved by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 4 shall remain the same.

The Town Board DO FURTHER ORDAIN that this Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication.
