

Recently, concerns have been raised suggesting that the Town of Oakland's current ambulance providers transport patients exclusively to Fort Memorial Hospital. To ensure transparency, the accompanying graph illustrates the hospital destinations to which Town of Oakland patients were transported during the reporting period.

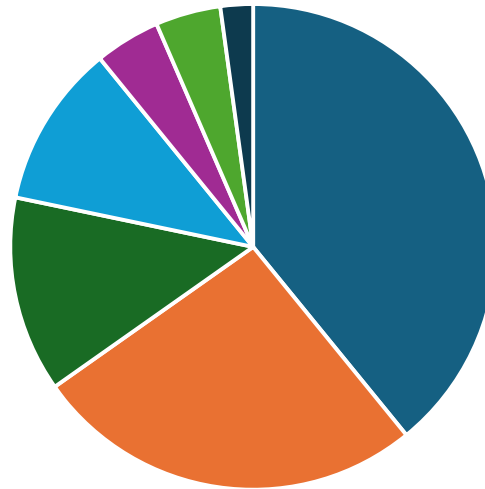
EMS providers remain committed to honoring each patient's hospital preference whenever clinically appropriate. However, certain medical conditions may necessitate transport to specialized facilities capable of providing advanced levels of care. Such facilities may include designated Stroke Centers, Cardiac Centers, or Trauma Hospitals.

The graph below shows that that only 39.13% of all patients from Oakland were transported to Fort Memorial, the remaining 60.87% were transported to other destinations per patient requests.

The numbers in this report are based on patients transported by Lake Mills EMS/Ryan Brothers EMS from 1/1/2026-07/31/2026
