TOWN OF ERIN PRAIRIE

ST. CROIX COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Town of Erin Prairie Board has been requested by its residents to adopt ordinances relating to Data Centers.

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that Small Scale Data Centers may not impose the same threats to health and safety as larger Data Centers.

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that Small Scale Data Centers are defined as occupying less than 1500 square feet within a larger building while serving only the needs of the larger building and consuming less than 500 kW per month.

WHEREAS, the Town Board needs time to research the issues and draft ordinances to address those concerns.

WHEREAS, the Town Board anticipates putting in place ordinances addressing Health and Safety, Licensing and Permitting Data Center projects.

WHEREAS, given the irreparable and unknown harm that may be caused by the installation and operation of Data Center projects.

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to address residents' concerns adequately and timely.

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes that a moratorium is needed to prevent any potential harm before the research is completed and ordinances are approved.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Erin Prairie shall place a moratorium on the permitting and construction of all non-Small Scale Data Centers within the town for a duration of one year from the date of adoption and posting of this resolution.
