2023 ELECTIONS

IMPORTANT TAX PAYMENT INFORMATION

Town Bank of Wales is no longer collecting taxes for the Village of Wales. Taxes are payable at the Waukesha County Treasurer's Office. The County provides a receipt for every tax payment. It will be mailed to you. You can also check your status online. Listed below are the three ways you can pay them at the County.

2023 DOG LICENSES

2023 Dog Licenses will be available now at the Village Hall. All dogs must be licensed by March 31, 2023, to avoid a \$5.00 late fee. Make checks payable to "Treasurer, Village of Wales."

Please remember to bring your dog's new rabies certificate with you if the previous one expired in

the past year. The certificate includes the date the shot was given and the date it expires, along

Snowplowing Season Is Here

Reminder: Village Ordinances prohibit snow from private properties being plowed across or onto a Village right-of-way. If you do either you may be issued a citation and/or assessed cleanup costs.

Markers

If you wish to install snowplow markers on your property please adhere to the following guidelines: the markers must be flexible and/or breakaway (usually plastic or fiberglass). They should be set 10 to 20 feet apart. Metal stakes are NOT allowed. The Village is not responsible for any damage to private markers placed in the Village right-of-way.

Mailboxes

The Village is not responsible for mailboxes that are damaged by snow load or ones that were already loose and knocked over by snow load. Check your mailbox and repair any loose, damaged or inadequately anchored ones. If the snowplow contractor hits your mailbox, please report it promptly to the Village Hall so that we can look into the damage.

Miscellaneous Items

The Village is not responsible for and will not replace underground sprinkler heads, lamp posts or other obstacles located in the Village's right-of-way if damaged during normal plowing operations.
