**PROCEEDINGS OF THE VILLAGE BOARD
OF THE VILLAGE OF REESEVILLE April 9, 2026**

A duly convened meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Reeseville, Dodge County, Wisconsin, was held in open session on April 9, 2026, and called to order by Village President, Jake Pacala, at 6:30pm. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Roll call was taken, and the following Trustees were present, Jessica Becker, Cheryl Goodrich, Sean Laylin, Anna Volkova, Jim Bublitz and President Jake Pacala. Kevin Hankes was absent. Notice of the meeting was given to the public at least 48 hours prior to the meeting by posting the complete agenda at the Reeseville Village Hall, the Reeseville Post Office.

Public comment: Jim Bublitz and Village Board presented Jamie Kilmartin with the Joan Beal First responder award. Jamie has 17 years of service on the First Responders with Village of Reeseville/CLR.

A motion to approve the minutes from prior board meeting was made by C. Goodrich, seconded by A. Volkova and the motion carried. A motion to approve the village treasurer report was made by J. Becker, and seconded by J. Bublitz, motion carried. A motion to approve the village utility report was made by J. Bublitz, and seconded by J. Becker, motion carried.

Engineer Report: Logan was present from Delta3 to go over the Capital Improvement Program; he gave a run down of all the changes that were made after the discussion at the committee meeting. J. Becker made the motion to go with the proposed Capital Improvement Program presented by Delta3, J. Bublitz seconded, motion carried. Delta3 will submit this program with Dodge County on behalf of the Village. Logan then asked the board what projects they would like to see done in the near future in order to get grant application started. It was discussed that the Village was awarded money from the LRP to start the Dewey Street project by 2027. Delta3 also plans to apply with the DNR for clean water loan. A. Volkova made the motion to move forward with applying for grants for Dewey and Sharp Street projects, J. Bublitz seconded, motion carried. Logan informed the Board they would start surveying in end of April/early May. Motion was made to have Delta3 take over all operations for engineering services with the exception to existing projects and building permits, motion made by J. Becker, seconded by A. Volkova, motion carried.

Public Safety Report: Parking ticket and Ordinance items were tabled. CLR is still planning to pursue a grant of starting up an EMS program working with Lifestar. National Night out is scheduled for August 4, 2026, more details to come.

Police Report: Dept. Schultz discussed that there were 35 contracted incidents and 33 non-contracted incidents for month of March.

CLR Report: Nothing to report

Life star Report: Nothing to report

Library Report: A. Volkova didn't have much to report except that numbers are up from 2025.

Infrastructure Report:

Utility Report: Ken reported that we have had lots of rain in short time frame, but the pumps are keeping up and running constantly. Well #1 getting prepared to have an emergency pumping set up. Specialty cheese is having a flow test tomorrow (4/10/26).

Administration Report:

Clerk-Treasurer Update: Kassie reported that W/S bills will be sent out late this quarter due to new credit card company getting fine details worked out. Election went very well per the County. Starting to work with the new auditors. The original field day was pushed to the end of April.

Health and Human Services: S. Laylin reported that he is working on getting a committee meeting set up on May 7th. Lauersdorf has repaired the cemetery ruts. He has also had conversation with GFL to get the ruts made at the mobile home park corrected as well. It was noted that the last large pick up went well.

Parks and Recreation Committee: J. Pacala mentioned that the Easter egg hunt went well, there was a good turnout. J. Becker motioned to start the Village Flea Market in May, seconded by A. Volkova, motion carried. A. Volkova motioned to approve Donkey Baseball event hosted by Mystic Car Club in June 2026, seconded by C. Goodrich, motion carried. J. Becker motioned to approve 5k walk/run hosted by Mystic Car Club and Craft Fair hosted by Lakeside 4H to be held June 20, 2026, seconded by A. Volkova, motion carried.

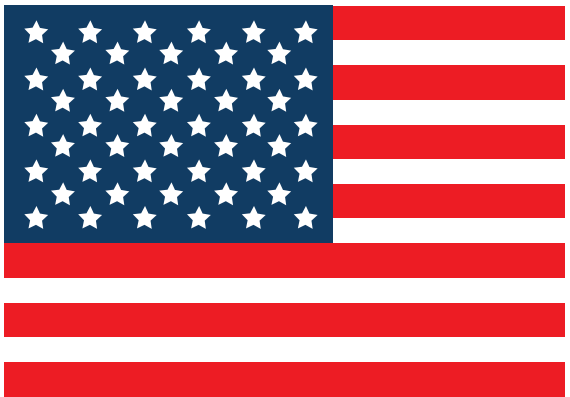
Planning and Development: C. Goodrich is looking into a few zoning questions brought to her attention.
