**PROCEEDINGS OF THE VILLAGE BOARD
OF THE VILLAGE OF REESEVILLE July 15, 2026**

A duly convened meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Reeseville, Dodge County, Wisconsin, was held in open session on July 15, 2026, and called to order by Village President, James Bublitz, at 6:30pm. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Roll call was taken, and the following Trustees were present, Jessica Becker, Anna Volkova, Cheryl Goodrich and President James Bublitz. Notice of the meeting was given to the public at least 48 hours prior to the meeting by posting the complete agenda at the Reeseville Village Hall, the Reeseville Post Office.

Public comment: None

A motion to approve the minutes from prior board meeting was made by C. Goodrich, and seconded by A. Volkova and the motion carried. A motion to approve the Special Board Meeting minutes 6/18/26 by J. Becker, and seconded by C. Goodrich and the motion carried. A motion to approve the village treasurer report was made by A. Volkova, and seconded by J. Becker, motion carried. A motion to approve the village utility report was made by A. Volkova, and seconded by J. Becker, motion carried.

Engineer Report: Kunkel sent over quotes for new electrical signs at the library from Westphal Signs and Sign Effectz. Kunkel recommended going with Westphal Signs for \$31,512.85. J. Becker made motion to approve quote from Westphal Signs, A. Volkova seconded, motion carried.

Public Safety Report:

Police Report: Dpt. Richardson reported there were 53 contract calls, 25 non-contract calls, and that they worked 49 hours month of June planning to make up 7 hours still owed in month of July.

Life star Report: 4 calls in the Village.

National night out update: Looking for donation from Village to cover costs.

Library Report: A. Volkova reported they are working on getting new sign installed. Physical circulation is consistent. There was a good turn out for reading with Watson.

Administration Report:

Clerk-Treasurer Update: Kassie reported that she has been attending schooling this week with UWGB. Looking into organizing and going through some paperwork. Looking for election worker for the PM shift for election on 8/11/26. Background documents were sent over for RCC bartender and new owner of BP station. Following up with moving elections to RCC. Operator license for Cheryl Goodrich was tabled. J. Becker made motion to approve Class B combination liquor and beer license for Reeseville Petro INC, C. Goodrich seconded, motion carried. J. Becker made motion to approve Class A combination liquor and fermented malt beverage for Reeseville Petro INC, A. Volkova seconded, motion carried. J. Becker made motion to approve cigarette license for Reeseville Petro INC, C. Goodrich seconded, motion carried. J. Becker made motion to approve operator licenses for Harjinder Signh, Preet Tiwana, and Simar Tiwana, A. Volkova seconded, motion carried.

Infrastructure Report:

Utility Report: Ken reported that N. Main lift needed work done due to mop head being stuck in check valves.

Discussion on removing stop sign on SW corner of Dewey and Garfield, need to change the ordinance.

Infrastructure committee made recommendation to change Joe Wagner to \$25/hr, full time (40 hours), all full time benefits. J. Becker made motion to accept recommendation to take affect 7/13/2026, A. Volkova seconded, motion carried.

Health and Human Services: Trash/recycling pick up had some issues this past week, lots of recycling items left on roads. Cardinal Lawns has been working on cemetery.

Parks and Recreation Committee: J. Bublitz reported that benches and lights have been fixed at ball fields. No update on Corn Roast yet. Village is taking over the out buildings at Fireman's Park, J. Bublitz stated he would work on drafting up a letter.

Planning and Development: J. Becker made motion to approve zoning variance for 308 Lincoln Ave to 12 feet high walls with max height of 15 feet at peak, C. Goodrich seconded, motion carried.

Future agenda items: No future items listed at this time

A motion to approve paying the bills was made by A. Volkova and seconded by J. Becker, motion carried. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by A. Volkova and seconded by C. Goodrich, motion carried.
