The town board would like to provide residents with an update on things that are happening in the town.

Highlights:

- The town is currently in the process of updating the website and town officials'/fire chief's email addresses. Stay tuned to the website at www.townofdeweywi.com for updates.
- Road work completed in 2023 can be viewed on the town website.
- The 5-year road plan can be viewed on the town website.
- The 2002 Sterling truck is being replaced. A new truck is expected in late 2024 or early 2025.
- The town board reviewed and updated all town ordinances. These ordinances are still undergoing review by the town's attorney before receiving final approval.
- ❖ A special thank you to Dewey firefighter Malayna Polum's daughter Autumn, who raised funds with her Girl Scout Troop 6260 and applied for a grant with the DNR to help pay for and install a Smokey the Bear fire danger sign on the corner of Sunset Drive and County Road X.

Things to consider:

- Portage County increased dog license fees. If you are a dog owner, please pay special attention to the new fees listed on the enclosed license application. Dog license applications are due April 1st, 2024 and may be submitted by mail. You are welcome to drop the application in the town hall lock box if you would like to save a stamp. Licenses will be issued beginning January 2nd, 2024.
- ❖ 1st installment taxes are due January 31, 2024 to the Portage County Treasurer's office. Payments can be made at their office, mailed, or made online by visiting the Portage County Treasurer's website. The following banks are also accepting payments: The Pineries Bank in Stevens Point, International Bank of Amherst and Community First Bank in Rosholt
- The town received four ExpressVote universal voting systems from Portage County this year. Voters can use the touchscreen to make their ballot choices. The clerk will hold an open house in early 2024 to demonstrate the new equipment.
