## **Ordinance No.27**

# An Ordinance for the Exemption from Treasurer's Bond for Tax Collections for the Town of Dewey

#### Section 1 – Title and Purpose

This ordinance is entitled an Ordinance for the Exemption from Treasurer's Bond for Tax Collections for the Town of Dewey. The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize the exemption of a treasurer's bond for tax collections.

#### Section 2 – Statutory Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Dewey, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 70.67 (2), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

### Section 3 – Adoption of Ordinance

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, authorizes the creation of an exemption for a treasurer's bond for tax collections as provided by this ordinance. A Public Hearing was held before the adoption of this ordinance and notice was given by publication of a Class 1 Notice, under Ch. 985, Wis. Stats.

### Section 4 - Applicability

A. That the treasurer of the town is exempted from giving the bond in s. 70.67 (2), Wis. Stats. B. That the town hereby obligates itself to pay, in case the town treasurer fails so to do, all state and county taxes that the treasurer is required to pay to the county treasurer.

#### Section 5 - Severability

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be deemed affected.
