

Resolution No.4 - 2025
Resolution to Designate Snowmobile Routes

Whereas, the Town Board of Supervisors, Town of Dewey, Portage County, has been requested to designate Town Right of Ways within the Town of Dewey as snowmobile routes pursuant to Section 350.047 of Wisconsin Statutes.

Whereas, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Dewey believes it is in the public interest to designate certain highways as snowmobile routes,


Now Therefore, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Dewey does hereby ordain as follows:


The following highways within the Town of Dewey, Portage County, shall be designated as snowmobile routes pursuant to Section 350.047 of Wisconsin Statutes:


- 1) Torun Road – starting at Dewey Drive going north for approximately 1 mile.
- 2) Maple Drive – beginning at Sunset Drive continuing west to Campsite Drive
- 3) Campsite Drive – starting from Maple Drive going north to the River's Edge Campground property
- 4) Haymeadow Drive - 100 feet south and 500 feet north of the bridge on Haymeadow Drive
- 5) Sunset Drive – starting at County Road X going west for .25 of a mile.

This approval will be granted on the condition that all snowmobile signs will be erected by the Pok-a-Snoz Snowmobile Club and inspected and approved by the Portage County Sheriff's Department. All snowmobile signs are the responsibility of the Pok-a-Snoz Snowmobile Club to be put up in the Fall and removed in the Spring. The Pok-a-Snoz Snowmobile Club shall be responsible to provide a copy of this Resolution to the local law enforcement departments.


