**RESOLUTION SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED
LOCAL LAW NO. 02 OF 2026 ABOLISHING THE ELECTED COMBINED OFFICE OF
TOWN CLERK / TAX COLLECTOR AND CREATING THE APPOINTED
COMBINED POSITION OF TOWN CLERK / TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Town Board is considering adoption of Local Law No. 02 of 2026 to provide that the combined office of Town Clerk / Tax Collector will be appointed rather than elected commencing January 1, 2027, and

WHEREAS, this legislation is authorized under New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Home Rule Law §20 requires the Town Board to hold a Public Hearing prior to the adoption of any Local Law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE
TOWN OF SANTA CLARA, FRANKLIN COUNTY, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Town Board shall meet on Thursday, July 9, 2026, at 5:30 PM to hold a Public Hearing to hear and receive comments from all people who are interested in proposed Local Law No. 02 of 2026, which would abolish the elective combined office of Town Clerk / Tax Collector effective at the end of the day on December 31, 2026, and create the appointive combined office of Town Clerk / Tax Collector effective as of January 1, 2027. Following such Public Hearing, the Town Board may take any other actions authorized by law concerning proposed Local Law No. 02 of 2026.

2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a Notice of Public Hearing in the *Adirondack Daily Enterprise* not less than five (5) days before the date of the Public Hearing and to make a copy of the proposed Local Law available at no charge to anyone who requests it.

3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

The question of the adoption of this Resolution by the Santa Clara Town Board was duly put to a vote on roll call and it was declared duly adopted.
