

Marcellon Road Maintenance Report for 2026

Road improvement in Marcellon Township is something the town board has made a top priority. We realize the roads have been deteriorating and they need greater attention than maybe in past years. Road improvement consists of 4 important parts.

- 1) Inspection
- 2) Brushing
- 3) Maintenance
- 4) Improvements based on available funds

As a new board we have undertaken the task of understanding how the county evaluates and rates each town road. In addition, we are attempting to be able to know the cost associated with each type of repair option we have available. To get some of those answers we will ask for cost estimates from several contractors. Each spring, the Town Board conducts a road tour to assess the structural condition of local roads and develop a maintenance and repair plan.

Road construction is a Town expense, funded by revenues generated through the Town. Occasionally the state will provide grants but due to the application process they are very difficult to obtain. Our budget for road work is reviewed and approved at the annual budget meeting, typically held in October.
