Snow Ordinance

DECEMBER 1 – MARCH 31

PARKING is PROHIBITED on all Village Streets between the hours of **12:00 AM and 6:00 AM** from December 1st – March 31st

Violators will be ticketed.

Please Note: Article 1219 of New York State VTL prohibits plowing, shoveling, or blowing snow into a street or highway

Christmas Tree Pick-Up

NOW – JANUARY 31

Please place **live trees** curbside for pick-up. No artificial trees will be picked up. Please do not place trees in the road. **Everything** must be **removed** from the tree in order for it to be picked up. Trees still containing decorations, tinsel, lights, tree stands, or other items will not be picked up. There is no set schedule for this program.

Keep Hydrants Clear

KEEP SNOW AND ICE 3 FEET AWAY FROM FIRE HYDRANTS
