**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD TO PROPOSE EXCEEDING  
LEVY LIMIT VIA TOWN MEETING**

**Whereas**, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city, and county levies for 2023 and thereafter under Wis. Stat. § 66.0602.

**Whereas**, Wis. Stat. § 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes limits the allowable local levy for 2023 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Herman is 0.489 percent;

**Whereas**, the Town Board of the Town of Herman, Dodge County believes that for the 2023 tax levy (collected in 2024) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 0.489:


**Whereas**, the Town of Herman 2022 payable 2023 adjusted actual levy is \$235,544; And further whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$1,093 for an allowable town tax levy of after adjustments of \$236,637 for 2023, collected in 2024.


Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Herman, Dodge County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2023 that will exceed the state levy limit.
2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) by 63.388% percent which would increase the town levy by \$150,000 for a total town tax levy of \$386,637, shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on November 13, 2023.
