

WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN?
A comprehensive plan is a long-range document which expresses a community's vision for how it will look in 20 years. The plan will address nine key elements and will establish goals and objectives to guide future growth. The creation of this plan is mandated by the State if a community elects to regulate land use using zoning, land division ordinances. Furthermore, the community must make regulatory decisions in a manner which is consistent with the comprehensive plan's vision and its Future Land Use Map.

WHO LEADS THE PLANNING PROCESS?
The planning process will be led locally by the Town of Herman Plan Commission. It is the Plan Commission's responsibility to review and approve the updated plan's materials as well as to consider public input.

HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE?
Town residents and interested/affected parties are encouraged to actively participate in this process. There are opportunities to voice concerns, suggestions, thoughts about how your Town should look in the future.
