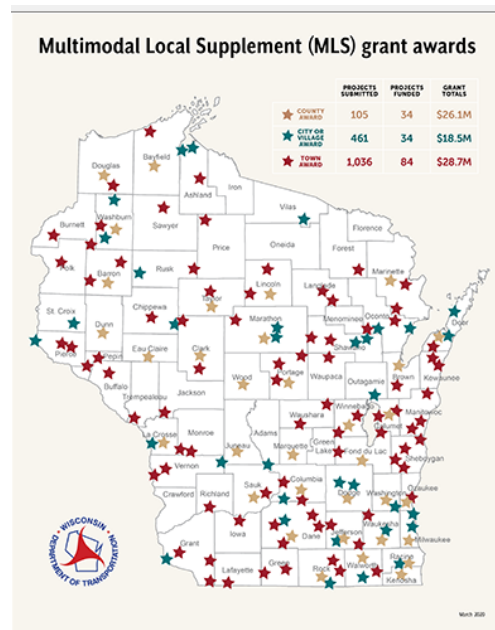
FARMLAND PRESERVATION - Nepeuskun has a newly approved State (DATCP) certified Farmland Preservation Plan. The next step will be for the Town to do some revisions to its Agricultural Zoning Districts and achieve certification by DATCP. Any landowners wishing to collect Year 2020 tax credits who are not currently participating in Farmland Preservation and wish to enroll, are encouraged to get working on a Nutrient Management Plan (NMP). If a NMP is in place for the 2020 crop season and any other performance standards regarding manure management and soil erosion are met, a 2020 tax credit may be possible. Time is certainly of the essence since spring is nearby. Assistance regarding all the performance standards can be acquired from the Winnebago County Land and Water Conservation Dept - (920) 232-1950. The Town will be holding at least one public informational meeting on this topic and will be sending out a direct mailing announcing the meeting over the next several months. Multimodal Local Supplement (MLS) Grant Awards - The one-time \$75 million funding program for local transportation projects announced the communities that will receive grant awards on March 4, 2020. The Town of Nepeuskun was one of the 152 communities that were awarded funds. The Town will receive \$335,017.87 for the reconstruction of Grams Road. This is 70% of the total cost of the project. DOG TAX EXTRA:

Neutered males / Spayed females	\$ 3.00
Unneutered males / Unspayed females	\$ 8.00
Multiple Dog License (includes up to 12 tags)	\$35.00 (+ additional \$3.00 per tag over 12 tags)

I MUST HAVE YOUR **VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE** VERIFYING THE DOG'S NAME, COLOR, BREED, WHETHER IT'S MALE OR FEMALE, (NEUTERED OR SPAYED) and DATE OF LAST RABIES SHOT, EXPIRATION DATE, TYPE OF VACCINE & MANUFACTURER'S SERIAL NUMBER BEFORE ISSUING A LICENSE. The certificate WILL be returned to you. If the dog is a combination of breeds, I must have a GOOD DESCRIPTION of the dog.
