Reedsville News Pricing

Pricing is per square (business card size), if you exceed you will be charged for each additional square

\$10/AD: Any school, church, or non-profit organization located within the Village of Reedsville

\$20/AD: Any school, church, or non-profit organization located outside the Village of Reedsville

\$20/AD: Any business/organization located within the Village of Reedsville.

\$30/AD: Any business/organization located outside the Village of Reedsville.

From the Village Hall

Garbage, Rubbish and Recyclables From Outside of Municipality: It shall be unlawful for any persons to place, deposit or cause to be deposited for collection, any garbage, rubbish or recyclable materials from outside the boundary limits of Reedsville into the Village unless authorized by an agreement with the Village.

Improper Use of Garbage, Rubbish or Recycling Receptacles: It shall be unlawful for any persons to place, deposit or cause to be deposited in or on any receptacle, or compost area not belonging to or assigned by the owner without the permission of the owner or designated assignee unless such receptacle or areas is designed expressly or implicitly for use by the general public.

Compost: Yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, and yard & garden waste shall be disposed of by composting the material or leaving it at the Village compost site. Items NOT to be put in the compost are: stumps, roots, shrubs with intact root balls, animal waste, pine cones and sod.

Defecation on Private or Public Property: It shall be unlawful for any person owning or in control of a dog or cat to allow or permit such animal to defecate on any private or public property owned by another person. Violation of this shall be punishable by a forfeiture of anywhere from \$20.00 to \$200.00

Trick or Treat Hours: The Village of Reedsville will hold Trick or Treat on Sunday, October 30, 2022 from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

Village Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday, August 11th, 2022

6:30 pm

1. Call to order

The monthly meeting of the Reedsville Village Board was called to order on August 11, 2022, at 6:30 PM by Village President Jesse Walt.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

3. Roll call

Present: Becca Fox, Terry Hansen(arrived at 7:40pm), Jennifer Maertz, Chad Rataichek(arrived at 7:23pm), and Jack Siebert

Absent: Becky Busse

Also, present: Chris Dallas, Don Goeke, and Tanner Raddatz

4. Approval of Agenda

A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Maertz to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

5. Public Appearances

6. Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Maertz to approve the July 14, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

A motion was made by Maertz and seconded by Fox to approve the July 21, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

A motion was made by Fox and seconded by Siebert to approve the August 4, 2022 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

7. Treasurer's Reports/Bills

A motion was made by Maertz and seconded by Siebert to pay the accounts payable in the amount of \$58,549.79. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

8. Correspondence

a. Correspondence was presented from Becky Busse resigning as Village Trustee. A motion was made by Maertz and seconded by Siebert to approve the resignation. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

b. Correspondence was presented from Don Goeke requesting a zoning change. Following a discussion, it was decided he would need a fire inspection, one will be scheduled with the Fire Chief.

c. Valders Ambulance Service July 2022 Report was presented for review. Dallas answered questions from the Village Board.

d. Correspondence from the Dept. of Natural Resources regarding the Phosphorus Compliance Alternative Plan. More information will be obtained for the August 18, 2022 meeting.

9. Department Reports

a. Fire Department

Fire Chief Jason Schuh submitted a written report.

July total calls - 2 Yearly Total - 3

i. A motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Fox to purchase bunker gear from Dinges Fire in the amount of \$13,079.75. Motion carried 4-0 (Walt voted).

ii. More prices will be obtained for replacing the roof on the Fire Station.

b. First Responders

First Responders President, Mike Kocourek submitted a written report.

c. Public Works/Utility Department

DPW, Jason Maertz, submitted a written report

i. The discussions on the USDA project, Hardball field will be postponed until the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting

ii. The discussion on the lawn cutting will be postponed until Spring of 2023.

iii. A flag pole will be purchased and electrical work will be done in the Parks

iv. A JD snow blower will be purchased from Riesterer & Schnell in the amount of \$4,200.00.

v. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Fox to replace 3 overhead garage doors on the Municipal Building from K-City Garage Doors in the amount of \$9,075.00. Motion carried 4-0.

vi. A motion was made by Rataichek and seconded by Siebert to remove the 2 10x12 doors and install 2 14x12 doors on the storage shed at an estimated cost of \$7,690.00. Motion carried 4-0.

vii. Public Works Dept will try out UTVs before the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

i. Ordinances from surrounding municipalities will be obtained regarding tourist lodging and fees.

ii. Updates on 2022 budgets will be discussed at a special meeting to be held on August 18, 2022 at 5:30pm. All Department Heads must attend.

iii. Proposed 2023 budgets must be ready for the next regular scheduled Village Board meeting.

At 8:18 pm, a motion was made by Siebert and seconded by Hansen to Convene into **CLOSED Session**, pursuant to WI Statute Section 19.85(1)(c) to conduct business which requires a closed session to consider employment, compensation and performance of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. Motion carried 5-0. Krahn asked to leave.

14. At 9:13 pm, a motion was made by Fox and seconded by Hansen to reconvene into **OPEN Session**. Motion carried 5-0. Krahn returned.
