

Water Conservation Notice

Reedsville

On Thursday, October 14th Reedsville Waterworks will begin conducting the first part of routine maintenance work on the Village's only operational well. We expect the work to be completed by Sunday, October 17th. During this time, the well cannot pump and the only available source of water for bathing and firefighting will be the water stored in the tower and the small reservoir on the south end of the Village. We are asking for your help to conserve water while we complete this work in order to minimize water pressure disruptions and maintain a supply of water for fighting fires.

What's the problem?

While we are implementing a variety of safeguards to prevent a loss of pressure in our water system while we conduct this work, we are asking you to minimize your water use during Thursday, October 14th through Sunday, October 17th in case we encounter unforeseen problems.

What can I do or not do?

Shorten shower times for the next few days, delay dish washing entirely until Sunday, October 17th, complete all laundry by Thursday, October 14th and postpone new laundry cycles until our work is completed, which is anticipated to be Sunday, October 17th. Do not wash cars, boats, trailers, driveways, or sidewalks. Do not water lawns and if you have an automatic sprinkler system, please change the settings from auto to off.

When will this be over?

If the conservation advisory can end before Sunday, there will be a notice posted. Otherwise, plan to resume normal water usage on Sunday. We will notify you by posting updated information on the village website at www.Reedsville.org or on the bulletin board outside of the village hall front entrance.
