Resolution to Adopt a Fair Housing Ordinance

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION - OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE -
ADOPTING WISCONSIN STATUTES, SECTION 106.50, AS AMENDED,
RELATING TO THE EQUAL RIGHTS OF ALL PERSONS TO FAIR HOUSING, AND
PROVIDING MEANS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Rockland Does ordain as follows:

Ordinance # 04-08- of the Town of Rockland, MANITOWOC County is created to read as follows:

Fair & Open Housing **FAIR AND OPEN HOUSING**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Town of Rockland recognizes its responsibilities under Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and endorses the concepts of fair and open housing for all persons and prohibition of discrimination therein;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

- 1) The Town of Rockland hereby adopts Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and all subsequent amendments thereto.
- 2) The officials and employees of the Town of Rockland shall assist in the orderly prevention and removal of all discrimination in housing within the Town's municipal jurisdiction by implementing the authority and enforcement procedures set forth in Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.
- 3) The Municipal Clerk shall maintain forms for complaints to be filed under Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and shall assist any person alleging a violation thereof in the Town of Rockland to file a complaint thereunder with the Wisconsin Department of Work Force Development, Equal Rights Division, for enforcement of Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.

**POLICY TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF EXCESSIVE FORCE
AND TO ENFORCE APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL LAWS
PROHIBITING PHYSICALLY BARRING ENTRANCES/EXITS
FOR NON-VIOLENT CIVIL RIGHTS DEMONSTRATIONS**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-08-2024d Non-Violent Civil Rights Demonstrations

A resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Rockland, to adopt the policy to prohibit the use of excessive force and to enforce applicable state and local laws prohibiting physically barring entrances/exits for non-violent civil rights demonstrations:

WHEREAS Section 104 (L)(1) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended (42 U.S.C. 69 §5304) prohibits the State from expending or obligating any Community Development Block Grant funds to any unit of general local government that does not have or adopt a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by local law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and a policy of enforcing State and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstration within its jurisdiction;


AND WHEREAS it is in the interest of the Town of Rockland to pursue Community Development Block Grant Funds and to adopt policy that complies with Section 104 (L)(1) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended (42 USC 69 §5304);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN CHAIRPERSON AND THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ROCKLAND:

- I. It is POLICY of the Town to prohibit the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within the Town's jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations.
- II. It is POLICY of the Town to enforce applicable State and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstration within the Town's jurisdiction.
- III. The officials and employees of the Town shall assist in the orderly prevention of all excessive force within the Town by implementing the authority and enforcement procedures set forth in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.
- IV. The Town Board directs the Manitowoc County's Sherrif to implement this Resolution by amending applicable law enforcement procedures.


