



RESOLUTION 2023-02 – A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISCONTINUANCE OF EAST MARTIN ROAD IN THE TOWN OF SEVASTOPOL PURSUANT TO WISCONSIN STATE STATUTE SECTION 66.1003

WHEREAS, this Resolution was introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol on June 19, 2023, Notice of Pendency of Application to Vacate the below-described Property was filed with the Register of Deeds for Door County on June 19, 2023; Notice of Hearing was published with a Class 3 Notice, a copy of said Notice was served more than 30 days prior to the hearing in the manner prescribed by law on the owners of all of the frontage lots and land abutting upon the portion of the road to be discontinued or a waiver of notice therefore was received; and a public hearing was held before the Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol on August 21, 2023 at 6:45 p.m.; and

WHEREAS no sufficient written objection to said discontinuance and vacation has been filed with the Clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the authority vested in the Town Board by Sec. 66.1003, Wis. Stats.:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol that E. Martin Road, located in the Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin and more fully described below, is hereby vacated, and discontinued, since the public interest requires it.

Legal Description:

A right-of-way strip for road purposes 3 rods wide between the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) and the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 26 East, Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the westerly 24.75 feet of said right-of-way strip.

The discontinuance of the above-described public way will not result in any landlocked property and no owner of property abutting the discontinued public way will be damaged by the discontinuance. Upon discontinuance of E. Martin Road as a public way, the land where E. Martin Road is located, including the right-of-way, shall be annexed to the owner of the adjoining lands pursuant to section 66.1005(1) Wis. Stats.

This resolution to discontinue a public way includes the written consent of the Town of Sevastopol to the discontinuance of all easements and incidental rights under Wis. Stat. 66.1005(2)(a) as part of these proceedings.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under Wis. Stat. 60.80.
