

TOWN OF SEVASTOPOL
ORDINANCE NO. 01-2001
Restrictions on Parking and Stopping

The Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1 - Authority

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted in Wis. Stats. Sections 60.22, 61.34 and 349.06 in strict conformity with state statutes.

Section 2 - Purpose

The Town Board may, when deemed necessary for the exercise of public safety, by ordinance, adopt restrictions on parking and stopping vehicles in the Town of Sevastopol.

Section 3 - Parking and Stopping Restrictions

No person may leave or park a motor vehicle on public or private property contrary to a sign posted thereon. The provisions of Wis. Stats. Section 346.55 (4) and any future amendments thereto are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference in order to make this ordinance in strict conformity with state statutes.

Section 4 - Penalty


The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be as established by the "Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule" as periodically revised by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.

Section 5 - Enforcement

This ordinance may be enforced by issuance of a citation to any violator of said ordinance, by any sheriff or deputy sheriff of the County of Door, by any State of Wisconsin officer with police powers or any duly appointed or elected law enforcement officer of the Town of Sevastopol.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and the day following its publication.
