

TOWN OF SEVASTOPOL
ORDINANCE NO. 03-2001
Speed Restrictions

The Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1 - Authority

The Town Board establishes, by this ordinance, in compliance with Wis. Stats. Sections 346.57 and 349.06, the following speed limits and authorizes signs to be erected to regulate and control traffic as set forth herein.

Section 2 - Purpose

The Town Board may, when deemed necessary for the exercise of public safety, by ordinance, establish the speed limit upon any highway over which it has exclusive jurisdiction as authorized by Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3 - Speed Limits

- A. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour at the following locations:
- (1) On South Cave Point drive from Whitefish Bay Road for a distance of 1.22 miles to its end.
 - (2) On Bark Road from Whitefish Bay Road for a distance of .59 miles to its junction with Glidden Drive.
 - (3) On West Shore Drive from Clark Lake Road for a distance of 1.09 miles to Townline Road.
 - (4) On South Lake Road from Clark Lake Road for a distance of 1.08 miles to its end.
 - (5) On Little Harbor Road from Bay Shore Drive .24 miles to its end.
 - (6) On Butterfly Lane from Whitefish Bay Road .12 miles to its end.
 - (7) On Cricket Lane from Butterfly Road .09 miles to its end.
 - (8) On Grasshopper Road from Butterfly Road .09 miles to its end.
 - (9) On Spider Lane from Valmy Road .06 miles to Butterfly Road.
- B. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 35 miles per hour at the following locations:
- (1) On Valmy Road from S.T.H. 57 .13 miles to Whitefish Bay Road.
 - (2) On Peterson Road from Sturgeon Bay city limits northerly for a distance of .56 miles to Gordon Road.
 - (3) On Dunn Road from its junction with S.T.H. 57 for a distance of .42 miles to its junction with Weber Road.
- C. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 45 miles per hour at the following location:
- (1) On Peterson Road from Gordon Road a distance of 1.25 miles to its junction with Walker Road.

D. The provisions of Wis. Stats. Section 346.57 and any future amendments thereto are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference in order to make this ordinance in strict conformity with state statutes.

Section 4 - Penalty


The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be as established by the "Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule" as periodically revised by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.

Section 5 - Enforcement

This ordinance may be enforced by issuance of a citation to any violator of said ordinance, by any sheriff or deputy sheriff of the County of Door, by any State of Wisconsin officer with police powers or any duly appointed or elected law enforcement officer of the Town of Sevastopol.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and the day following its publication.
