**ORDINANCE NO.: 2-96**

**An Ordinance to Stagger the Terms of Town Supervisors**

The Town Board of the Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1 - Purpose/Authority.

Due to the expansion of the Town Board from three members to five members effective January 1, 1997, five supervisors, which includes the Town chairperson, will be elected at the Spring, 1997, election. Pursuant to §60.21(2)(c), Wis. Stats., the Town Board hereby staggers the terms of the supervisors.

Sec. 2 - Terms of Town Supervisors.

The chairperson and the 2 supervisors receiving the highest number of votes in the Spring 1997, election shall serve 2-year terms, and the other 2 supervisors shall serve one year terms, with each subsequent election to be for 2-year terms so that elections occur in both odd-numbered and even-numbered years.


Sec. 3 - Conflicts.

All ordinances in whole or in part in the Town of Sevastopol which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


This Ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication.
