

**TOWN OF SEVASTOPOL
ORDINANCE NO. 98-04
State Fire Code**

An ordinance to adopt the State Fire Code and related sections in the Town of Sevastopol and to assign enforcement responsibility and penalties for violation thereof.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF SEVASTOPOL, DOOR COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Purpose:

The town may, when deemed necessary for the protection of persons and property in the Town of Sevastopol, by resolution or ordinance, adopt regulations for the prevention, detection and suppression of fire and related hazards within the Town of Sevastopol.

Section 2 - Authority:

The Town Board establishes, by this ordinance, and in compliance with Wis. Stats. Section 60.555, regulations to prevent, detect, and suppress fire and related fire hazards in the Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin.

Section 3 - State Fire Code Adopted:

1. The following provisions of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and subsequent amendments thereto, are adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance:
 - a. ILHR Chapters 8 and 10 - State Flammable Liquids Code
 - b. ILHR Chapter 11 - Liquefied Petroleum Gas Code
 - c. ILHR Chapter 12 - Liquefied Natural Gas Code
 - d. ILHR Chapter 13 - Compressed Natural Gas Code
 - e. ILHR Chapter 14 - Fire Prevention Code
 - f. ILHR Chapters 50-64, 66, 69 and 70 - Commercial Building Codes
 - g. ILHR Chapter 28 - Smoke Detectors
 - h. IND Chapters 160-64 - Existing Buildings

2. Applicability. Every building or structure hereafter erected, altered, or moved, within or into the Town of Sevastopol shall conform to the requirements of these chapters.

Section 4 - Enforcement:

The fire chief of the Sturgeon Bay Fire Department and his fire inspectors are assigned responsibility to enforce this ordinance. The fire chief and fire inspectors of such department are given specific authorization to issue municipal citations for violations of this ordinance. No building permit shall be issued to allow construction which would violate the provisions of this ordinance. This ordinance may further be enforced by injunction.

Section 5 - Penalty:

The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be a forfeiture in the sum of \$10 - \$200 for each violation thereof. Each day a violation continues shall be considered a separate violation.

Section 6 - Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect one day after its passage and publication as provided by law.
