RECAP OF STORM CLEAN-UP FOR
AUGUST 26, 2024

- No formal call out of personnel. Members that did go out to patrol and remove trees/debris, included: Jim & Sandy Rassbach, Mike & Cindy Leidholm, Bob and Peggy DeVoe, Tom Meisner, Karl Nordin, Ted Hakala, Todd Johnson. Tim Stowasser of Town Maintenance went out. Bob Davis did not go out but manned the radio to coordinate activities and to record actions being taken.
- Reported by Chairman Meisner on August 29th that he did declare an emergency call out of the LEPC. It is assumed because of poor radio transmissions that night that members didn't hear the alert.
- Trees were removed, or pathways were cut on Chippewa Trails, Right-a-way, Indian Mission, Willy and Dzwiela.
- There weren't a great number of trees down and no other property damage was noted.
- All roads were patrolled
- Patrols started at about 9:30 and were completed by 12:30 AM
- Roads needing follow-up on August 27th, include Right-a-way @ the boat landing, South of Elsner farm on Chippewa Trails (may be Town of Sampson responsibility), Dzwiela, Willy and the end of Indian Point. The loader backhoe is needed at Indian Point. This communicated to Marc Weisner by 8:30 AM, August 27th
- Only known problem was overall poor radio reception. Rassbach Communications was consulted and it may be because new batteries are needed because these radios all have the original batteries. Will be asked to be on agenda for September Town Board meeting for discussion and possible action.
