

# Title 10

# Sec. 10-1-21

The Town Board of the Town of Big Bend, Rusk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Big Bend is subject to the following restrictions and limitations: No Parking on either side of Plummer Road as posted near McCann Public Landing; and No Parking on either side of Willy Road as posted in the area of the rookery.

B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture in accordance with current State-issued citation schedule..

This ordinance is effective on posting on February 2, 2012.

The town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
