RESOLUTION #02-01
ESTABLISH HOURLY WAGE FOR TOWN OFFICERS
SERVING AS TOWN EMPLOYEES

whereas, 60.37(1) of Wisconsin Statutes allow that the town board may employ, on a temporary or permanent basis, persons necessary to carry out functions of town government, including any elected officers of the town, and

whereas, 60.37(4) of Wisconsin Statutes states elected town officers may be paid an hourly rate, not to exceed \$5,000 per year, and

whereas, the electors must establish the hourly rate to be paid to town officials serving as town employees,

Now therefore be it resolved that we, the town electors of the Town of Big Bend, Rusk County, Wisconsin, being duly assembled at the annual meeting on April 13, 2002, do hereby authorize compensation not to exceed \$ 11.00 or prevailing rate per hour to any elected town officer employed in the following positions, unrelated to his/her regular responsibilities as town officer: town truck driver, snow plow driver, general maintenance and road maintenance pursuant to s.60.10(1)(g) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
