RESOLUTION 2001-04
ACCEPTANCE OF BID FOR TOWN TRUCK

WHEREAS, the Town of Big Bend currently owns a 1988 GMC truck, and

WHEREAS, the town truck has a single position blade making it cumbersome to plow town roads, and

WHEREAS, extensive repairs on the town truck increase each year, and

WHEREAS, the current truck is not equipped to handle large snowfalls, and

WHEREAS, a truck that could clear the roads in two passes rather than four would save the town time and money, AND

WHEREAS, the electors of the town directed the town board to obtain quotes on a new town truck with necessary equipment at the April 14, 2001 Annual Meeting,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the town board of the Town of Big Bend, being duly assembled at the Special Meeting on June 28, 2001 do hereby authorized the purchase of a new town truck and equipment, at a cost not to exceed \$81,498.00. (Truck will be purchased from River States Truck Sales and equipment will be purchased from Menomonie Trucking per bids received.)
