Ordinance # 21

PROHIBITING PARKING ON TOWNSHIP ROADS AND STREETS
DURING SPECIFIED PERIOD

WHEREAS, the parking of motor vehicles on Township roads and streets during the winter months interferes with and in some cases prevents the plowing and removal of snow from said roads and streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township of Jackson hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

Parking on Township roads and streets during the period from November 15 through March 31 is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.
