Ordinance No. 22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS ON TOWNSHIP ROUTES

The Township of Jackson, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The operation of motor vehicles, trailers or semi-trailers having a weight in excess of twelve tons and motor vehicles, trailers or semi-trailers with loads thereon and having a gross weight in excess of twelve tons is prohibited on all Township Routes or portions thereof in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. Official signs setting forth the prohibitions and limitations set forth in this Ordinance shall be installed on all Township Routes in accordance with the provisions of the Act of April 29, 1959, P.L. 58, Section 1101 (75 P.S. 1101 (b)).

SECTION 3. Any person refusing to unload excess weight when so ordered by a peace officer in uniform, or violating any of the other provisions of this Ordinance shall upon summary conviction before a Magistrate be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.
