RESOLUTION NO. 07-04

THIS RESOLUTION, approved and adopted by the Supervisors/Council members of JACKSON Borough/City/Township, CAMBRIA County, Pennsylvania, on the date hereinafter set forth.

WITNESS TO:

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) was signed by the President of the United States on October 30, 2000 (Public Law 106-390) to reinforce the importance of mitigation planning for disasters before they occur.

WHEREAS, DMA 2000 establishes a pre-disaster hazard mitigation program and new requirements for national post-disaster hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Cambria County Department of Emergency Services has developed the Cambria County Hazard Mitigation Plan which identifies existing and potential sites and situations where disaster may occur throughout every municipality in Cambria County and identifies potential initiatives to mitigate those situations; and

WHEREAS, we as municipal leaders recognizing that many hazards, emergency situations, and disasters do not strictly adhere to municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, in a spirit of cooperation, are mindful of the safety and needs of residents and businesses not only in our own municipality but of those throughout Cambria County; and

WHEREAS, the Cambria County Commissioners have accepted the Cambria County Hazard Mitigation Plan as a document to be used for the entirety of the county;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors/Commissioners/Council of Borough/City/Township do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Cambria County Hazard Mitigation Plan to be used as a document for the betterment of Borough/City/Township in an attempt to prevent disastrous situations or to deal with the traumatic effects to the municipality should a disaster occur.
