

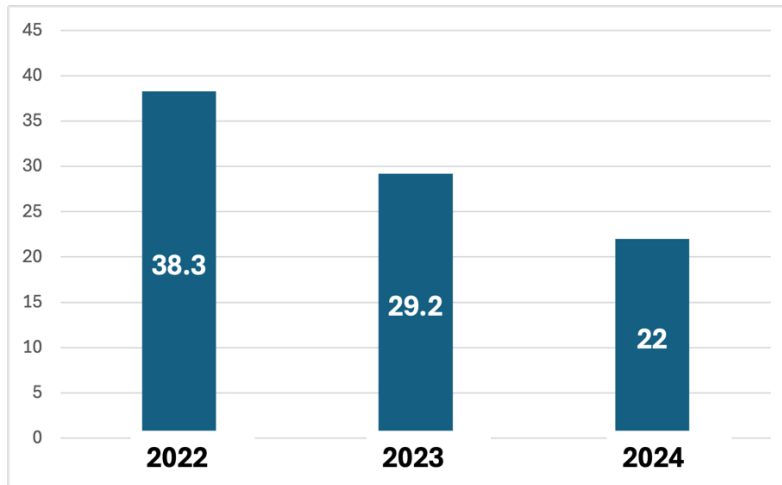
Town Of Gardiner Facility Benchmarking Report 2022-2024

Overview

As a Clean Energy Community, the Town of Gardiner participates in the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (“NYSERDA”) Facility Benchmarking Program. This program provides visibility to our town buildings’ energy use through the online Energy Star Portfolio for each building greater than 1,000 square feet. On an annual basis, the Climate Smart Gardiner Taskforce coordinates with Town staff to gather and enter data into the EPA’s Energy Star Portfolio website from which the data below were created. Please note that the data reflect the actual consumption of electricity by month whereas the fuel oil for the Highway Garage and the propane for Town Hall are recorded when delivered.

One of the goals of the Climate Smart Gardiner Taskforce is to assist the town’s efforts to reduce its air and climate pollution while reducing operating expenses.
