THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Commissioner of Public Works, having jurisdiction of the Town and County Roads of the County of Ulster, does hereby close a section of the road known as;

County Route 7A, Mckinstry Road,
In the Town of Gardiner in said County of Ulster

County Route 7A, Mckinstry Road in the Town of Gardiner, approximately 0.3 miles northwest of the intersection with Albany Post Road will be closed to all through traffic effective Tuesday, April 21, 2026, to facilitate the culvert replacement project. Traffic may use Mckinstry Road southeast for 0.3 miles, to Albany Post Road south for 2.6 miles, to Long Lane west for 1.2 miles, to Hoagerburgh Road north for 1.3 miles, to Bruynswick Road north for 1.8 miles, to Mckinstry Road east for 2.2 miles.

The necessity for such closing consists that the replacement work cannot be completed while maintaining traffic on the road which is a COUNTY road and is being closed under authority vested by Section 104 of the Highway Law.
