ORDINANCE 9

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE SANITARY LAND FILL IN THE TOWN OF BURNETT, DODGE COUNTY.

The Town Board of the Town of Burnett, Dodge County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Town of Burnett Sanitary Land Fill is owned, maintained and licensed by the Town of Burnett and is open only to residents of the Town on the following schedule:

April thru November Saturday 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

December thru March Saturday 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

Section 2. Dumping in the Town of Burnett Land Fill site is strictly limited to ordinary household garbage and refuse. Fencing, stumps, rocks, dead animals, hazardous waste, old car bodies and any other items which would impede the orderly operation and sanitary condition of the site, is strictly prohibited.

Section 3. All residents are required to display a sticker before using the facility. The stickers may be obtained, one to a family, at the home of our constable, who will be in charge of attaching and recording the permits.

Section 4. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall pay a fine of \$50.00 plus costs.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and publication as provided by law.
