Minutes of the January meeting were approved by M/Sietsema 2/Baartman/cd unanimously.

The council approved to authorize Bollig Engineering to begin collecting data for the required Federal Lead Service Line Inventory and to apply for the MDH Grant to pay for the Lead Service Line Inventory Report by M/Sietsema 2/Rupp/cd unanimously. There is NO fee to collect the data or to apply for the inventory grant.

Wastewater Supervisor, Darrin Haroldson gave the council his report for the month of January and answered the council's questions.

The January bills were presented and approved by M/Baartman 2/Sietsema/cd unanimously.
