

ORDINANCE NO. 96-1

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON A PORTION OF BOWERS ROAD IN THE TOWN OF TROY.

The Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle on any portion of Bowers Road for a distance of ~~4000~~ 500 feet South of County Trunk Highway "ES".

SECTION II. Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$300.00 and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment thereof, but not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication or posting according to law but shall not be enforced until official traffic signs or markings have been placed or erected indicating the prohibition contained in this ordinance.


