Chapter 19
Amendment to Ordinance 2004-2
Traffic

1. **TITLE.** This ordinance is entitled the "Town of Troy Traffic Ordinance"
2. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to ensure a safe and healthy environment for the citizens of the Town of Troy and vehicles operating within its borders.
3. **AUTHORITY.** The Town of Troy is a political subdivision and municipality of the State of Wisconsin organized and existing under Chapter 60 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
4. **GENERAL PROVISIONS.** Except as otherwise specifically provided in the Code, The statutory provisions in Chapters 340 to 348 of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, and the Regulations of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any regulations incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this code. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutory regulations on Chapters 340 to 348 incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Code in order to secure to the extent legally practicable uniform statewide regulation of vehicle traffic on the highways, streets and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.
5. **SPECIFIC PROVISIONS.** The following specific provisions are hereby enacted in addition to those incorporated from Chapters 340 to 348 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
 - (a) **NO PARKING.** The following areas are "No Parking" areas as defined by these Ordinances and marked by authorized traffic signs.
 - (1) There is no parking on Nature Road North from Bluff Road to the Waukesha County Line.
 - (2) There is no parking on any Town Road or Town Road Right of Way from November 1st to April 1st of any given year.
 - (3) There is no permanent parking or storage of any motor vehicle, watercraft, or trailer on Town Roads or Town Road Right of Ways.
 - (4) There is no parking on Town Line Rd. from Highway 20 to the southern limit of St. Peters Road.
 - (5) There is no parking on County Road N, First St., and Briggs St. between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - (6) There is no parking anytime at Fire Department's water point on Pickeral Lake Road.
 - (b) **SPEED LIMITS.** The Town Board hereby determines that the statutory speed limits on the following streets or portions thereof are unreasonable, unsafe, and imprudent and modifies such speed limits as follows:
 - (1) There is a 35 mile per hour speed limit on Town Line Rd. from Highway 20 to ES.


- (2) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone on Town Line Rd. from Highway 20 to St, Peter's Rd.
- (3) There is a 35 mile per hour speed limit zone on Town line Rd. from St. Peter's Rd. to Kittie Court.
- (4) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone on Briggs St.
- (5) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone on Bluff Rd. From Cemetery West to 67.
- (6) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone on Palmyra Rd. From Cemetery North to 67.
- (7) There is a 45 mile per hour speed limit zone on Pleasant Lake Rd.
- (8) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone on Booth Lake Heights Rd.
- (9) There is a 25 mile per hour speed limit zone in the Trojan Hills Subdivision
- (10) There is a 45 mile per hour speed limit zone on Pickeral Lake Road from County Road J to State Road 20.
- (c) PLANTINGS. No plantings may be placed in Town Road Right of Ways without the authorization of the Town Board.

6. PENALTIES. The Penalty for violations of any provisions of this Code shall be a forfeiture as hereafter provided together with costs under Sec. 345.20, Wis. Stats.

- (a) FORFEITURES FOR UNIFORM TRAFFIC OFFENSES. Forfeitures for violations of any traffic regulation set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes adopted by reference in Section 4 of this chapter shall conform to the forfeiture or penalty permitted to be imposed for violations of the comparable state statute, including any variations or increases for subsequent offenses; provided, however, that this subsection shall not permit prosecution under this chapter of any offense for which an imprisonment penalty may be imposed upon the defendant.
- (b) FORFEITURES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.
 - (1) UNIFORM STATEWIDE OFFENSES. The minimum and maximum forfeitures for violations of the offenses described on ss346.51 to §346.55, Wis. Stats., adopted by reference in Section 4 of this chapter, shall be \$20.00 dollars and \$40.00 dollars, plus court costs and the costs of prosecution.
 - (2) OTHER PARKING OFFENSES. The penalty for all other parking violations not included in paragraph (1) above shall be a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 dollars nor more than \$100.00 dollars, plus court costs and the cost of prosecution.
