Chapter 19 ORDINANCE 2016-02

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE SPEED LIMIT ON PALMYRA ROAD AS 35 MILES PER HOUR

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.57(4)(g) establishes a Statutory Speed Limit of 35 miles per hour for semiurban districts outside the corporate limits of a city or a village; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.57(1)(b) defines semiurban districts for purposes of establishing the 35 mile per hour speed limit; and

WHEREAS, upon investigation the Town Board finds that the length of Palmyra Road north of Highway 67 to the County line in the Town of Troy is a semiurban district, as statutorily defined; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Troy finds that 35 miles per hour is a speed limit that is reasonable, safe and prudent for the protection of the health and public safety on Palmyra Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, **DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1:

The speed limit on Palmyra Road north of Highway 67 to the County line in the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, is hereby declared to be 35 miles per hour.

SECTION 2:

The Town of Troy Department of Public Works shall post speed limit signs giving notice of the 35 miles per hour speed limit on the foregoing section of Palmyra Road, as required by Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.57(6) and other applicable laws.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other

provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
