

ORDINANCE NO 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT ON TOWNLINERoad IN OR ADJACENT TO BOOTH LAKE MEMORIAL PARK

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Troy has the authority pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 346.57(4)(i) to establish a speed limit of fifteen miles per hour on any street or town road, except a state trunk highway or connecting highway, within, contiguous to or adjacent to a public park or recreation area when children are going to or from or are playing within such area, when the local authority has enacted an ordinance regulating such traffic and has properly marked such area with official traffic control devices erected at such points as said authority deems necessary and at those points on the streets or town roads concerned where persons traversing the same would enter such area from an area where a different speed limit is in effect; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that the public safety requires such fifteen mile per hour speed limit to be imposed on Townline Road adjacent to the Booth Lake Memorial Park; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: A speed limit of fifteen miles per hour is hereby established on Townline Road in the Town of Troy adjacent to Booth Lake Memorial Park, for the full length of the park, when children are going to or from or are playing within such area.

SECTION 2: The Town of Troy Public Works Supervisor is authorized and directed to post official signs at such points as said he deems necessary and at those points on the town road where persons traversing the same would enter such area from an area where a different speed limit is in effect, in the form and manner required by Section 349.065, Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3: Violations of this ordinance are subject to the forfeitures established for the comparable State offenses, including any variations or increases for second offenses as listed in the Revised Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in

conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
