As we've been calling residents about leaks, we've discovered that quite a few phone numbers are no longer in service. We've heard everything from "This number has been disconnected" to reaching someone who definitely doesn't live in Buhler! If you've changed your phone number or email address recently, please give City Hall a quick call or stop by so we can update your information. We'd much rather call you about a possible leak than have to send smoke signals.

Keeping your contact information current helps us get in touch quickly if we notice unusual water usage or if there's another important utility issue. A two-minute update today could save you from a much bigger headache later.

As summer comes to a close, we want to wish all of our students, teachers, school staff, and parents a wonderful school year. Whether you're excited for the first day or wondering where the summer disappeared to, we hope this new season is filled with success, learning, and maybe just a little extra patience during the morning drop-off line.

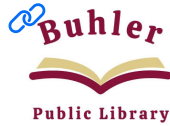

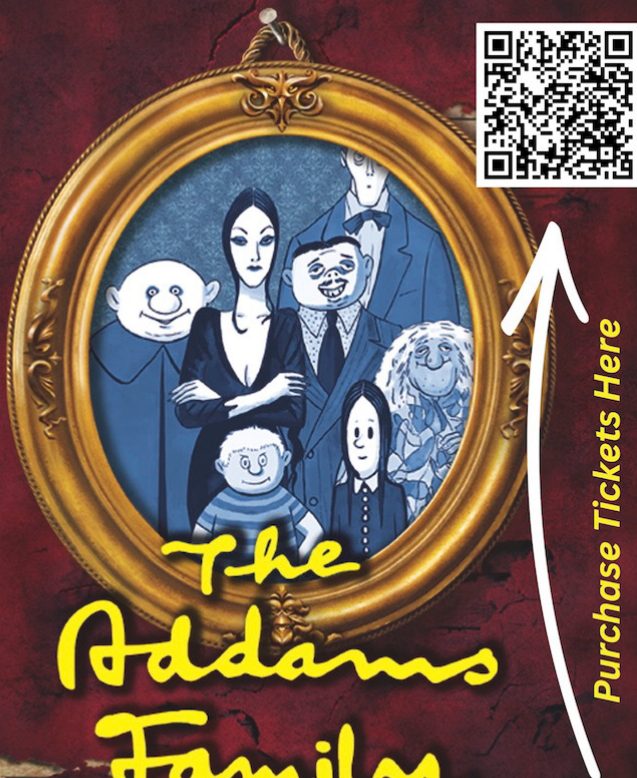
