

Town of Spider Lake

Part-Time Public Safety Officer

Position Term

Approximately 80–100 hours between June 15, 2026 and September 15, 2026

Position Summary

The Town of Spider Lake is seeking a part-time Public Safety Officer to patrol the main bodies of water within the Town of Spider Lake and assist with enforcement of the following Town ordinances:

- Ordinance 02-2024 – Boating Regulations
- Ordinance 2025-1 – Wake Enhancement Activity
- Ordinance 2026-1 – Slow-No Wake on the Teal and Lost Land Lake Connector

Qualifications

Applicants must:

1. Hold current State of Wisconsin certification as a law enforcement officer
2. Have a minimum of one year of law enforcement experience
3. Not be a resident or taxpayer of the Town of Spider Lake

Duties

The Public Safety Officer will conduct random patrols on the Spider Chain of Lakes, Lost Land Lake, and Teal Lake during peak boating hours, at the officer's discretion.

Responsibilities include:

- Monitoring boating activity for ordinance compliance
- Educating boaters regarding Town regulations
- Issuing warnings or citations, when necessary, for ordinance violations

Equipment

It is desirable, but not required, that the individual provide an acceptable boat, motor, and trailer for use in performing these duties.

Employment Status

The individual will serve as an independent subcontractor to the Town of Spider Lake.

Compensation

\$8,000 – \$10,000, depending on experience and equipment availability.
